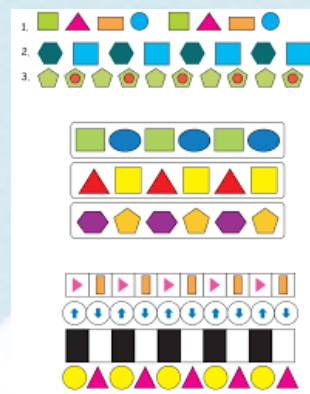
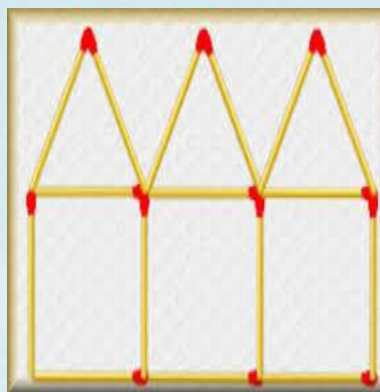
## MATHEMATICS
