नई शिक्षा नीति, 2020

हाल ही में प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र मोदी द्वारा नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति लाई गई जिसे सभी के परामर्श से तैयार किया गया है। इसे लाने के साथ ही देश में शिक्षा पर व्यापक चर्चा आरंभ हो गई है। 'शिक्षा' का तात्पर्य महात्मा गांधी के अनुसार - बालक और मनुष्य के शरीर, मन तथा आत्मा के सर्वांगीण एवं सर्वोत्कृष्ट विकास से है। इसी प्रकार स्वामी विवेकानंद का कहना था कि मनुष्य की अंतर्निहित पूर्णता को अभिव्यक्त करना ही शिक्षा है। इन्हीं सब चर्चाओं के मध्य हम देखेंगे कि **1986** की शिक्षा नीति में ऐसी क्या कमियाँ रह गई थीं जिन्हें दूर करने के लिये नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति को लाने की आवश्यकता पड़ी। साथ ही क्या यह नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति उन उद्देश्यों को पूरा करने में सक्षम होगी जिसका स्वप्न महात्मा गांधी और स्वामी विवेकानंद ने देखा था?

सबसे पहले 'शिक्षा' क्या है? इस पर गौर करना आवश्यक है। शिक्षा का शाब्दिक अर्थ होता है - सीखने एवं सिखाने की क्रिया। परंतु इसके व्यापक अर्थ को देखें तो शिक्षा किसी भी समाज में निरंतर चलने वाली सामाजिक प्रक्रिया है जिसका कोई उद्देश्य होता है और जिससे मनुष्य की आंतरिक शक्तियों का विकास तथा व्यवहार को परिष्कृत किया जाता है। शिक्षा द्वारा ज्ञान एवं कौशल में वृद्धि कर मनुष्य को योग्य नागरिक बनाया जाता है।

गौरतलब है कि नई शिक्षा नीति, **2020** की घोषणा के साथ ही मानव संसाधन मंत्रालय का नाम बदलकर शिक्षा मंत्रालय कर दिया गया है। इस नीति द्वारा देश में स्कूल एवं उच्च शिक्षा में परिवर्तनकारी सुधारों की अपेक्षा की गई है। इसके उद्देश्यों के तहत वर्ष - **2030** तक स्कूली शिक्षा में **100% GER** के साथ-साथ पूर्व-विद्यालय से माध्यमिक स्तर तक शिक्षा के सार्वभौमिकरण का लक्ष्य रखा गया है।

महत्त्वपूर्ण तथ्य :-

- ☑ अंतिम राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति, **1986** में बनाई गई थी जिसमें वर्ष **1992** में संशोधन किया गया था।
- ☑ वर्तमान नीति अंतरिक्ष वैज्ञानिक के. कस्तूरिंगन की अध्यक्षता वाली समिति की रिपोर्ट पर आधारित है।
- ☑ नई राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति, **2020** के तहत वर्ष **2030** तक सकल नामांकन अनुपात को **100%** लाने का लक्ष्य रखा गया है।
- ☑ नई शिक्षा नीति के अंतर्गत केंद्र व राज्य सरकार के सहयोग से शिक्षा क्षेत्र पर जीडीपी के **6%** हिस्से के सार्वजनिक व्यय का लक्ष्य रखा गया है।

- ① पाँच वर्ष की फाउंडेशनल स्टेज - **3** साल का प्री-प्राइमरी स्कूल और ग्रेड **1, 2**
- ① तीन वर्ष का प्रीपेटेरी स्टेज : तीन वर्ष का मध्य (या उच्च प्राथमिक) चरण - ग्रेड **6, 7, 8** और **4** वर्ष का उच्च (या माध्यमिक) चरण - ग्रेड **9, 10, 11, 12**

Chhath Puja

Chhath puja is a festival that is dedicated to the worship of 'Surya'.

The term ' chhath ' refers to the six days of the lunar fortnight of the kartik month. Chhath puja is thus, celebrated six days after Diwali. In astrology, 'Surya' i.e. sun is considered to be the ruler of all planets, giver of life and energy on earth. He is worshipped for curing all diseases and promoting endurance. The goddess who worshipped along with surya is ' Chhathi maiyaa'.

It is believed that chhat Devi is the sister of Lord Surya so, people offer 'arghya' to the sun and worship the sun to please chhathi maiyaa.

Chhath puja is one of the major festivals of Bihar and is celebrated over period of 4 days. The first day is called ' Nahaai khaai' , which means to take bath and eat. The second day is called 'kharna' on this day the people who are doing chhath observe a fast, in the evening they offer puja to surya after which they end their fast. The third day is marked by the elaborate evening prayers which is called as 'sandhya arghya'. The fourth day is considered as very auspicious day on which people offer prayers to the morning sun, which is called as 'bihaan arghya'.

Chhath puja is also mentioned in the Mahabharata. It was believed that chhat puja was performed by Draupadi, wife of the Pandavas during the years of exile. The worship of surya helped Draupadi to solve her problem and helped the Pandavas to regain their kingdom.

Chhathpuja involves worship of the nature and this is what our Indian tradition. People who are fond of chhat puja join this ritual with enthusiasm with family and friends. When chhath puja gets over the prasaad is distributed. The festival not only helps to gain inner peace but also it gives chance to meet our family members, spend time with them and enjoy the rituals.
